You are going to learn:

- 1-The past continuous tense
- We use the past continuous tense for a progressive action that happened in the past.
- We form the past continuous with:simple past of «to be»
 (Was / were) + verb + ing

eg: Yesterday, they were watching T.V

Negative: was not / were not + verb + « ing »

eg: He was not having dinner yesterday

Interrogative: Was / were + subj + V+ Ing

eg: Were you doing your home work?

We use the past continuous tense + while to express 2 actions that happened at the same time (2 simultaneous actions)

-While can be placed at the beginning of the sentence or between the 2 sentences

eg: While I was watching T.V, he was reading a book

Or: I was watching T.V while he was reading a book

REMEMBER

Past continuous tense: Was / were + verb + « ing »

eg: They were playing a football match

Negative: Was not / were not + V+ ing

eg: She was not preparing lunch

Interrogative: Was / were + sub + v +ing

eg: Were they cleaning the house?

While: 2 simultaneous actions

eg: While he was looking for his keys, I was shaving

or: I was shaving while he was looking for his keys
