The Imperative:

Sentences that make commands.

A command is a sentence that tells or orders us to do something.

<u>eg</u>:

Speak quietly in the lunchroom.

Don't stay in the sun.

Describing a process:

You use the passive in the present simple:

eg:

Water is boiled.

Eggs and sugar are added.

***** The <u>sequencers</u> which are used are :

First, then, next, after that, finally.

Betsy feels bad.

Amine: Hi, Betsy! How are you?

Betsy: I have a terrible headache.

Amine: Take some aspirin. Apply ice on your head and go to bed.

Don't stay in the sun.

Betsy: Thank you, Amine.

Amine: Sarah! Bring some tea for Betsy, please!





REMEMBER

***** The imperative sentence :

- may end with a period or an exclamation point. eg: Shut the door!

Brush your teeth.

- may make a simple request :

eg: Lend me a pen.

- may be a command or order:

eg: Keep quiet!

- may be an instruction:

eg: Pour the liquid.

- may give a direction:

eg: Take the next turn to the right, don't turn left.

The passive form in present simple is used when things are finished.

eg: The dishes are washed.
