

Seeds

A seed is a little plant . It is a plant that has not started to \mbox{grow} . Some seeds \mbox{grow} fast . Some \mbox{grow} slow .

All seeds have covers . Some are very big . Others are very small .

When water soaks into the seed, the seed begins to grow. The seed first sends a tiny root down into the earth. Then it sends a stem above. The stem is a little plant. It is called a sprout. The plant and the roots grow bigger and longer.

Some seeds travel .The wind and water carry seeds .

Some seeds get eaten by man or animals. All seeds need earth , water , and sunlight to grow .
