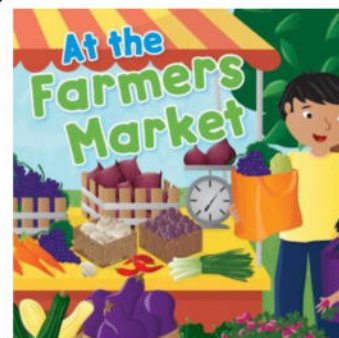


The First Term English Exam
