

Taha Husayn was one of the most influential 20th-century Egyptian writers and intellectuals,he was born on Nov. 4, 1889, in Maghagha,a mill town in Minya Provence, Egypt. He became blind at the age of three from a combination of eye disease and folk medicine. After completing studies at the village mosque school, Taha was sent to Cairo (1902) to attend al-Azhar, the mosque university. Because of his outspoken opposition to the school's teaching system at al-Azhar, Husayn was failed in his final examinations. He enrolled in the new, worldly Egyptian University, where he studied with some of the leading scholars of the time, Egyptian and European, in the field of Arabic and Islamic studies. In this heady new atmosphere, Husayn received the first doctorate awarded by the university (1914) for his thesis on Abu-l-Ala al-Maarri. Al-Ayyam and the Pre-Islamic Poetry criticism book were from his most famous work.
