Do you want to be a better reader? Turn off the television! A recent study found that kids younger than 10 spend about two hours a day watching TV, playing video games, or using computers. That is about the same amount of time they spend with a book! The study which was released on Tuesday included more than 1,000 parents of kids between the age of 4 and 10 years.

Spending a lot of time on the computer, watching TV or playing video games can make it hard to get better at reading. Kids who live in homes where the TV is on “most of the time” are less likely to be able to read by age 6.

Although the modern means of communication are invading the modern World ,reading is still popular among people. Almost 80 per cent of kids under 6 are exposed to books. In fact researches say kids spend an average of 49 minutes a day with a book. And what is the average amount of time spent in front of the TV or computer? About 2 hours and 22 minutes!

Victoria Rideout, a researcher for the study, says “Kids, who watch TV, use computers, and play video games will have an advantage in their lives.” “Media can help their learning, but there are disadvantages too, they may develop weaknesses in reading,” she adds.

Dr. Henry Shapiro studies kids’ development and behaviour. He says: “reading, playing with toys, and talking with others is much better for kids’ learning than watching TV”. He also says: “There is a good side of TV, computers and video games; kids are at home, safe, they are also learning things.”
