More than 250 people were killed when a military plane crashed in a field outside Algeria's capital on Wednesday April 10th, 2018, in a terrific air disaster. The plane was heading to Tindouf but crashed on the airport's perimeter in Bourafik, Algeria's defence ministry said. The defence ministry also confirmed: "this disaster is the worst air disaster in the country's history".

Television footage showed crowds and emergency vehicles grouping around the smoking and flaming wreckage near Boufarik airport. A line of white body bags could be seen on the ground next to what media said was a Russian Ilyushin transport plane. A total of 257 people were killed, most of **them** military. Ten crew and other people described as family members also died, and a number of survivors were being treated at an army hospital.

Algeria's defence ministry issued a statement expressing condolences to families of the victims. Besides, on behalf of other countries such as China, Chinese President Xi Jinping said: "I am shocked by the news of the crash, which resulted in heavy casualties". <u>He</u> also sent condolences to his Algerian counterpart, Abdelaziz Bouteflika as well as to the grieving families over the deadly military plane crash.
