A new report claims that genetically modified foods can damage your health and even cause cancer, but some experts say they 're an inexpensive and healthy way to put dinner on your table.

Today, due to advances in biotechnology, scientists can genetically engineer different species so that they share the same genetic material. For example, they can move the gene from a fish that lives in cold water into tomato so it can survive in cold weather.

A new French study found that a new type of corn called "NK603" that has been genetically modified to be tolerant of a commonly used herbicide, which could eliminate surrounding weeds, but it would also be present in small quantities in the foods we eat. The scientists fed rats with "NK603" that contained levels of the herbicide. They found the rats eventually developed massive diseases after seven months and died earlier than animals fed a "regular" diet.

However, scientists who are in support of GMF'S say the research is mistaken. They claimed the authors used a breed of rats that were bred to develop diseases as they aged anyway. The authors failed to mention the amount of food given in the article, which is important since high amounts of food, GMF'S or normal can increase the risk of illness.

Despite the results of the contested study, more researches need to be done on the long-term effects of genetically modified foods on humans. Until that happens, many European countries, like Russia and the UK, have already banned certain types of GMF'S for human consumption.
