The mosque was designed and constructed by the China State Construction Engineering Corporation (CSCEC) on August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2012. It sits on an area of 400,000 square metres and has a minaret with a height of 265 metres high that makes it the tallest building in Africa. The mosque includes a praying hall of 20, 000 square metres which can hold a capacity of 120,000 worshippers. The mosque's complex also houses a Quran school, a library, an amphitheater, staff housing area, a park, a fire station, a museum of Islamic art and a research centre dedicated to the history of Algeria.

*Martyr's Memorial*

*The Martyr's Memorial or "Maquam Echahid" is an iconic monument located in Algiers, Algeria. It was designed by the Algerian painter "Bachir Yelles" and the Polish engineer "Marian Konieczny". This concrete monument was built in 7 months and 20 days on the site of an ancient military fort. It is fashioned in the shape of three standing palm leaves which shelter the "Eternal Flame" beneath. This monument stands 92 metres tall and has a diameter of 14 metres. It rests on an esplanade that includes the underground National Museum of El Mujahid and it is free to visit. It is a truly architectural work and an attraction that gives visitors lasting memories.*
