When the earth-quake occurs, the ground will shake perceptibly for a relatively short time; perhaps only for a few seconds, perhaps for as much as a minute in great earth-quake. The motion is apt to be frightening, but you have no choice except to wait for it to end. So, it is very important to remain calm and in control of yourself. If you act calmly and deliberately you will increase your chances of being safe from harm. Furthermore, other people near to you may benefit from your calmness and follow your example.

Act immediately when you feel the ground or building shaking, keep in mind that the greatest danger is from falling debris. Don't worry about being embarrassed if you hide under desk. The people who wait to see whether or not such action is necessary are the ones who are most likely to be hurt by falling objects. Tell yourself to remain calm and don't do things that upset other people; such as shouting or running around.

If you are indoors; move immediately to a safe place. Get under a desk, a table or work bench if possible. Stand in an interior doorway or in a corner of a room. Watch out for falling debris or furniture. Stay away from windows, chimneys, and heavy objects such as refrigerators and walls. If you are inside a high building; don't rush for stairs or lifts. If you are in a vehicle, calmly stop the car away from buildings and bridges if possible. Remain in the car until the shaking is over.
