A Class Trip to Ghardaia

Last October ,we made a class trip to Ghardaia. We went there by bus. We started from Relizane in the early morning and drove through Tiaret, Aflou, Laghouat where we had a stopover to have lunch and relax for one or two hours.

Afterthat, we continued our way up to Ghardaia. We were there at 16.00. It was a fantastic feeling to see this ancient town for the first time. We spent the first night in RYM hotel which was small but beautiful. In the next morning, we walked to see the old souk where I bought various traditional items. And then ,we had some nice time just driving and visiting the local places and the fascinating sights like old ksours and palm grooves.

The next day, we drove to Beniyezguen, It is a historical town and the birth place of the outstanding poet Moufdi Zakaria. This attractive city is surrounded by walls which were made as protection from the enemy in the past. It was founded between 1012 and 1350 but it is not as ancient as the other cities of Ghardaia . In1982, Beniyezguen was listed (inscribed) as a world heritage by UNESCO. We met a lot of tourists there .

The following day, we went to visit the house where the great poet of Algeria Moufdi Zakaria was born . Our tourist guide told us that he was born on April 12th, 1908. He studied in Annaba then in Tunisia where he learnt to use both Arabic and French. Once back in Algeria, he was imprisoned many times. When he was freed, he joined the Algerian revolution in 1955 . Moufdi is most known for the Algerian national anthem which he wrote. He also has two famous groups of poetry named 'allahab al mouqaddass' and 'ilyadat aljazair'. He died in1977 in Tunisia but his body was buried in Algeria.

I'll always remember this trip because it was really different and fantastic.


Algeria was and still is the home country for many worldwide celebrities and outstanding figures in history ,sport , literature, art and modern technologies.

Moufdi_Zakaria

Zakaria Chikh as was his actual name was born on April 12th, 1908 in Bni Yezguen (Ghardaia). He was given the nickname of *Moufdi* by a school friend. He studied in Annaba then in Tunis where he learnt to use both Arabic and French in the Khaldounia and then the Attarine schools, He was very clever and popular.

During his stay in Tunis, he met and became a friend of Abou el Kacem Chebbi and Ramdhane Hamoud.

Once back in Algeria, he joined the North African Muslim Students Association and was close to the Associations of the Algerian Muslim Oulemas.

In 1937, the French administration jailed him together with Messali ElHadj and released him in 1939. Once free, he helped to create a "ach-cha3b" journal.

Between 1940 and 1948 he has been imprisoned many times for almost 4 years. When he was freed, he joined the Algerian revolution in 1955.

The French arrested him again in April 1956 and he spent 3 years in Serkadji. After his release, he went to Morocco then Tunisia where he wrote in El moujahid newspaper.

Moufdi Zakaria is the poet of the Algerian Revolution and is most known for the Algerian national anthem which he wrote. He also has two famous groups of poetry named 'allahab al mouqaddass' and 'ilyadat aljazair'. Zakaria died in 1977 in Tunisia but his body was buried in Algeria.
