One other point that you want to research when purchasing a new computer is the help factor. Larger computer companies have phone numbers that you can call with questions on your computer. Some companies only offer this service for the first few months, others only offer it at a certain time of day or week. You should make sure that the help line is available to you whenever you need it. You should also make sure that you won't be billed for asking for help, some companies charge you for the help they give you.

Overall, purchasing a computer can be an easy task if you know what you want and how you will use it. You can solve a lot of problems by researching the companies and products that they sell. If you feel comfortable with the company and the service that you receive, it will make buying a computer a lot less stressful on you.
